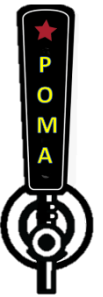




POUR ME A COLD ONE

Please do not feel apprehensive or intimidated by this event, they are by no means experts. They have their own personal tastes and enjoy sharing a *Cold One* with colleagues, family, and friends.

Bring along your own opinions, tastes, knowledge, and recommendations. If possible, with proper social distancing and pandemic precautions in mind, try to have 1 or 2 others join you to add to your enjoyment of this experience.

The beers listed are all available at numerous Pennsylvania groceries and beer distributors. In most cases you can “build your own 6 pack” so you don’t need to purchase the same type or brand of beer. We encourage you to visit your local brewers to find beers that match the types we will be discussing, or to try something completely different.

There are various types and variants to beer, but we will focus on these 6 common types. Examples of each are provided below:

- **AMERICAN LAGER:**
 - Budweiser; Michelob Ultra; Samuel Adams Boston Lager; Yuengling
- **PILSNER:**
 - Pilsner Urquell; Warsteiner, Becks, St. Pauli Girl; Founders Pilsner; Victory Prima Pils;
- **PALE ALE:**
 - Dale’s Pale Ale; Moosehead Pale Ale; Sierra Nevada Pale Ale; Yards Pale Ale
- **INDIA PALE ALE (IPA):**
 - Dogfish Head IPA; Founders All Day IPA; Goose Island IPA; Troegs Perpetual IPA
- **PORTER:**
 - Deschutes Black Butte Porter; Harpoon Dunkin’ Coffee Porter; Yuengling Porter; Hershey’s Chocolate Porter
- **STOUT:**
 - Guinness Extra Stout; Samuel Smith Oatmeal Stout; Stone Wootstout; Troegs Java Head Stout



Additional items to consider having on hand to enhance the experience:

- **Food/Munchables:**
 - Salty Snacks: Pretzels, Nuts, Chips
 - Sweet Savory: Cheeses, Dark Chocolate/Chocolate
- **Glasses:**
 - Anything from a solo cup to a beer mug. Users’ choice
 - For sampling, 3-ounce cup or shot glass. The glass or cup can affect flavor and carbonation.
- **Miscellaneous:**
 - Bucket, bowl, or other receptacle for dumping rinsed water or beer not drunk
- **Yourself, a spouse, partner or friend, and an expectation to have fun!**
