
Dear POFPS Nominating Committee Members,

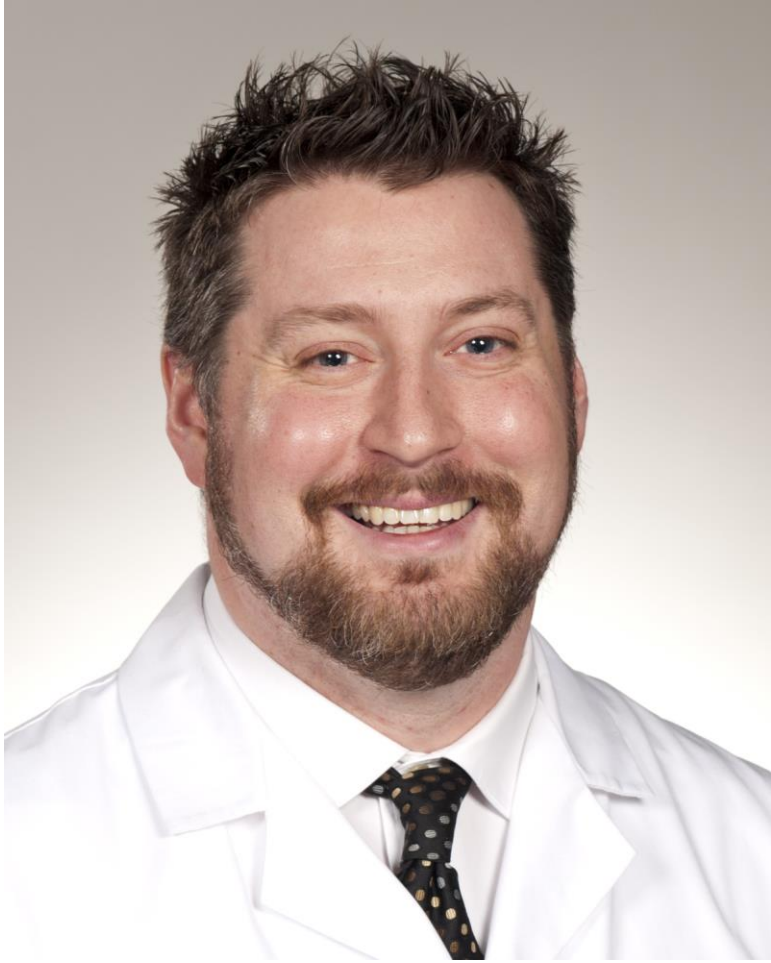
