Using the POMA CME Module on the POMA Website

The POMA CME module houses your cumulative CME report and conference CME statements (certificates). This module is a member benefit so you must be an Active member of POMA to access the platform. For best results, we recommend using the Chrome browser when working with our CME module.

To access, log in to the POMA website, www.poma.org



Once logged in, select "My CME" in the Quick Links menu.



A new browser window will open and display your CME record interface. You will be able to see three things:

- 1. A summary of your credits broken into the state licensure requirements for the current reporting cycle
- 2. Buttons for POMA-sponsored conference certificates, if available
- 3. A list of all of your individual CME records for the current reporting cycle

Understanding the CME Credit Summary

The CME Credit Summary by Category assists members in tracking the CME credits that they have earned within a specific state licensure cycle. The current licensure cycle will always be displayed. The primary categories of interest include Category 1A AOA credits, Patient Safety credits, Child Abuse Education credits, Opioid Education credits, and a total of all other credits. Clicking on the green question mark provides an explanation of all credit types included in the category.

The numerical summary indicates the number of credits approved in a category for the current licensure cycle and the number of credits required in a category for the current licensure cycle. Numbers in green indicate that the requirements for a particular category have been met. Note, the totals of each category will not equal the total number of credits earned since some categories will be included in others.
